Open to AKC Registered or FSS recorded Dachshund & Terrier Breeds: Australian, Bedlington, Border, Cairn, Cesky, Dandie Dinmont, Fox (Smooth & Wire), Glen of Imaal, Lakeland, Manchester, Miniature Bull, Miniature Schnauzers, Norfolk, Norwich, Parson Russell, Rat Russell, Scottish, Sealyham, Silky, Skye, Welsh & West Highland White.

Dogs must be at least 6 months old. Dogs registered with the AKC or recorded with the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) of eligible breeds and dogs that are spayed or neutered or have a Limited Registration or Purebred Alternative Listing number may participate.

TESTS OFFERED

- Intro to Quarry** 10 feet, one 90-degree turn
***Junior Earthdog:** 30 feet, three 90-degree turns
Open to all dogs that have not earned a Senior Qualifying leg.
***Senior Earthdog:** 30 feet, three 90-degree turns, with false den and exit, recall
Open to all dogs that have completed a JE, SE or ME title
***Master Earthdog:** 30 feet, three 90-degree turns, with false entrance, den and exit, indication of entrance, honor another working dog. Open to all dogs that have completed a SE or ME title.
***NON "ME-TITLED" DOGS MAY ONLY ENTER ONE OF THE STARRED CLASSES/DAY**
ME TITLED DOGS MAY ENTER MULTIPLE CLASSES IN ONE DAY
Irondog: ME titled dogs only. Must run in Sr. and ME tests same day.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Ribbons & Rosettes: Qualifiers all classes will receive flat ribbons
Those dogs earning titles will receive rosettes

AWARDS: GPDC bead or lanyard for qualifying Irondogs.

Bitches in season are not eligible for entry. Entry fees will not be refunded. Bitches in season must not be allowed to interfere with the running of the tests.

All dogs are to be held on short leash under control while on the test grounds. For everyone's safety, dogs shall NOT be LEFT UNATTENDED in exercise pens while on the grounds.

Spectators shall be allowed outside the test area provided that they are quiet and do not distract the dogs. No dogs shall be allowed within 100 feet of test areas.

Confirmed entrants not present at the testing area when their number is called will be moved to the end of the class except for ME class. In the ME class, any dog not present within 5 minutes after its brace is called will be marked absent by the judge. The remaining dog in that brace will be run as or with the bye dog.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be reimbursed in guaranteed funds. Checks will not be accepted. The Earthdog Secretary will add a collection fee of \$15 to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. Any awards won by dogs with invalid entries because of NSF will be rescinded unless the club is reimbursed immediately.
