

This month, the HRKC donated \$2,000 to the Port Angeles Police Department K-9 Unit. The donation will be used to provide additional training to benefit the program. The PAPD has two active K-9s: Bodie and Copper. They're pictured here with their handlers Officer Miller and Officer Fairbanks.





Sequim PD K-9 Unit Donation

We also donated \$1,000 to the Sequim Police Department K-9 Unit! Sequim PD K-9 Mamba is handled by Officer Dailidenas. K-9 Mamba is Sequim's fourth ever police dog and the city's first female canine crime fighter. She is trained to conduct human tracking and apprehension, building searches, evidence searches, and handler protection. The Sequim Police Department K9 program is funded through donations. HRKC BOARD MEETING MINUTES October 11, 2022

Meeting was called to order by President Lorraine Shore at 6:10pm via Zoom.

In attendance: Board Members: Lorraine Shore, Jo Chinn, Lynne Duke, Jan Garrison, and Susan Parr.

A quorum constitutes a majority of the board and there were 5 out of 7 in attendance so a quorum was met.

This board meeting was called specifically to determine the amount of money HRKC will donate to non-profit organizations in 2022.

Prior to the meeting, Treasurer Jo Chinn submitted the account current balances:

Washington Federal Money Market: \$9,373
Washington Federal CD: \$31,956
Sound Community Bank checking account: \$29,329

Jo noted that the new club trailer was purchased at a cost of \$14,111.00 which will leave \$15,218.00 in the club checking account. The club will need to purchase new Obedience equipment prior to our June 2023 ARO.

Lorraine started the discussion by noting that 100% of the raffle proceeds are to be donated as that has been the mission of our club raffle each year. The raffle netted \$5,484.00 in 2022. Carolyn Money motioned at the prior club meeting to donate the amount of money collected in "Brags" over the years and that motion was passed. Jo Chinn advised that amount is \$206.00.

Lorraine advised that club members submitted four organizations to receive donations in 2022:

- Port Angeles Police K9 Unit
- Sequim Police K9 Unit
- Canine Health Foundation
- Center Valley Rescue

Jo Chinn suggested the club donate an even amount of \$6,000.00 in 2022 which would leave a little over \$9,000.00 in our checking account to cover upcoming expenses.

Susan Parr agreed that \$6,000.00 was appropriate and would include the raffle, brag money and some of the money raised by the eye clinic. The amount could be split evenly among the four organizations.

Lynne Duke also agreed that \$6,000.00 would be reasonable amount to donate this year.

Lynne asked if Jo knew how much the club anticipated spending for the obedience equipment. Jo said it depended on who we purchased the equipment from, but it would be anywhere from \$800.00 to possibly \$1400.00.

Jan agreed that donating \$6,000.00 would leave the club with enough money to cover anticipated expenses.

At the last club meeting, there was a motion passed that if both the Sequim and Port Angeles K9 Units were selected to receive a donation, the PAPD K9 Unit receive twice the amount of Sequim. The reasoning was the Port Angeles Police have two K9s and Sequim PD has one K9.

MOTION: Susan Parr moved to donate \$6,000.00 in 2022 to the four non-profit organizations nominated by the membership: Sequim PD K9 Unit, PAPD K9 Unit, Canine Health Foundation and Center Valley Rescue with the PAPD K9 Unit receiving \$2,000.00, Sequim PD K9 Unit receiving \$1,000.00, Canine Health Foundation receiving \$1,500.00 and Center Valley Rescue receiving \$1,500.00. Jan Garrison seconded the motion.

The motion was unanimously approved.

Secretary's Report: Nothing to report.

Treasurer Report: Mariko read the report as submitted by Jo Chinn. Current balances: Washington Federal Money Market \$9,385, Washington Federal CD \$ 31,963, Sound Community Bank \$6,691.94. Income and Expenses: 1) Began preparing information for the tax preparer 2) Re-filed the annual report with the Secretary of State because we were rejected. Their website provided wrong form, so she had to do it over again.

Yumi needs at least a deposit to acquire new ring gates for Obedience. Lorraine will get her a check.

Scent Work Trial: Mariko will get together with Susan to finalize a date, possibly March/April for Trial, and possible Judges.

Old Business: None

New Business: Lorraine announced the 2022 Volunteer of the Year is Joe Larson. Lorraine held up the beautiful plaque with a great photo of Joe and read the inscription. At the January meeting, Lorraine will present Joe with his plaque.
