Minutes  
June 16, 2021

**Approval of Minutes:** The 5-19-21 minutes were emailed to members prior to the meeting. Nancy/Lynne motioned to accept minutes as written. Unanimously approved.

**President's Report:** Thank you to all our wonderful club members and volunteers who made our Agility/Rally/Obedience Trials a success once again! Agility Chairs Steve Chinn and Nancy Radich and Obedience/Rally Chair Chris Cornell did a great job. The Equestrian Team is fantastic and there were a tremendous number of volunteers that worked all three days from set-up to take down. We couldn't put on these shows without our great club members and volunteers.

**Treasurer Report:** Jo Chinn gave an account current report. Trophy donations were deposited and Jan Garrison did a great job as Trophy Chair garnering donations for our show. The trailer licenses were renewed. The ARO numbers are almost complete and as of this meeting it appears we will not lose money on this trial.

### **2021 Shows:**

**ARO June 4, 5, & 6:** Steve Chinn and Nancy Radich were the 2021 Agility Chairs and Chris Cornell was the Obedience/Rally Chair. The shows went very well and the only issue was windy weather on Saturday. The club will need to replace a canopy that was damaged by the wind. Lynne Duke did a great job manning the check in table and Steve remarked that he stopped counting at 24 volunteers that helped take the show down on Sunday. The entire site was cleaned and everything put away in less than two hours thanks to the wonderful volunteers.

**All Breed July 30, 31, & August 1:** Joe Larson is the 2021 All-Breed Show Chair and Chris Cornell is the Obedience/Rally Chair.

Set-up for the show will be on Thursday, 7/29 and more information will be emailed regarding the need for volunteers. Volunteers will be needed on Sunday afternoon to help take the show down.

Premium list is on BaRay website and entries open on Friday, 6/25 and close on 7/14. Show site is at the Carrie Blake Ballfields. The AKC rep limited the number of dogs to 900 based on the site map. Average entry is around 600 so it shouldn't be an issue.

City needs to remove the eco blocks and Chris will ask Travis to remove them. The cars/rvs will enter by the Pickle Ball court and the CERT Team will collect parking money and direct traffic. Susan Parr is in charge of RV Parking.

Chris will check on Field Mowing. Vendors will include Savvy Dog, Dell (Dog Beds) and Lorraine will check with Green Cup and Shaffett's Sharpening to see if they will be there. Pat Click at 3Cs confirmed she will not be coming.

Public food vendor is the Crepe Guy and the club will need to provide food for the judges, stewards and workers. The plan is to rent the Guy Cole Center Kitchen and Lorraine and Anne will work on getting the hospitality taken care of.

Carolyn Money and Lynne Duke have worked very hard on the Raffle and there is an incredible amount of amazing items that have been donated, including a size 400 Impact Crate which the company sent as a donation. Only 200 tickets at \$5.00/ticket will be sold for the Impact Crate. They've collected \$1200.00 in gift certificates from a wide variety of businesses as well. This will be an amazing raffle!! Lorraine will ask Dell if he will provide security as he's done in the past. If he agrees, his vendor fee will be waived.

Chris Cornell will send out a request for stewards for Obedience/Rally.

**Scent Work October 16<sup>th</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup>:** Ben and Leah had to leave after the Board meeting but said they have the paperwork to AKC and the Fairgrounds have the dates reserved.

### **New Business:**

**Club Meeting Locations:** This was our first in-person meeting since COVID restrictions were implemented.
