ARO – Chris Cornell reports that both Alice Peterson and Hazel Polbrook will be Obedience and Rally Judges for 2021. Sue Lightner is checking her 2021 schedule and hopes to be with us in 2021. Steve Chinn says Judges will work out for next year. Jo Chinn checked on room reservations for judges and found that the hotel had already cancelled them. She will be sure that July's reservations are still intact.

All Breed July 24 – 26: Joe Larson reports that Premium List has been submitted. Ribbon order has no date. Vendor's fees to be paid at the show, as requested by the vendors. Lorraine Shore mentioned that the Working Dog Club was sending Judges a note on how our area is addressing COVID19. Jan Garrison is concerned about offering more than rosettes as Trophy donations are few. Lorraine asked the cost of the awards as listed in the Premium. It was estimated at \$2600 to \$2900. Decision on Premium due April 24th. Entries open on May 27th. Cost to produce Premium, estimated by Joe to be roughly \$4000. Susan Parr has had 5 calls from handlers asking if show will be a go, as Woofstock was cancelled. Additional discussion as to offering only ribbons and complexity of show due to COVID19, Chris requested that we wait for booking Judges' flights. Lorraine will draft a statement for the Club's Facebook and Website. Susan Parr would prefer to hold onto RV parking checks to avoid any complications if show cancelled.
