



Major Edmund F. McKnight Jr., 87, of Prescott, AZ, passed away on June 4, 2017.

Ed was a loved husband, father, grandfather and a proud retiree of the U.S. Air Force. Ed was born to Edmund F. and Mary J. McKnight on January 3, 1930 in Los Angeles, California. Growing up in Los Angeles, he was active in Boy Scouts, Sea Scouts and and the DeMolay fraternal organization. He attended Garfield High School, where he competed in gymnastics and played on the football team. Shortly after graduating, Ed enlisted in the Air Force and trained as an aircraft mechanic. In 1953 he

entered Aviation Cadet Training, earning a commission as a 2nd Lieutenant and graduating with his wings as a navigation officer. He went on to earn his pilot wings in 1956 and pursued a love of flying throughout his career. His




