Secretary's Report: Received AKC Event numbers approval for All Breed dates July 30, 31 and August 1, 2021.

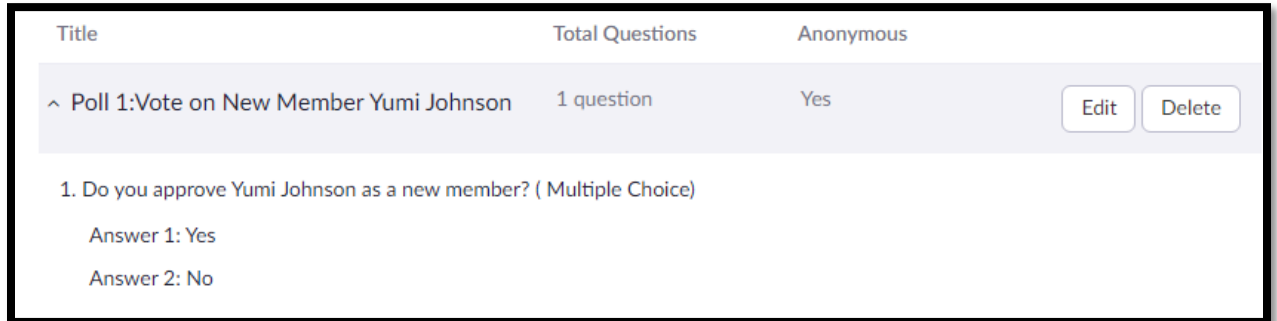
Committee Reports:

2021 Shows: Camille Stephens advised that the January 2021 Obedience and Rally Premium is ready. The trials will be held in Port Townsend at the McGregor Training Building Jan 29 - 31, 2021. Our deadline for cancellation, due to COVID restrictions, is January 11th so hopefully that won't be necessary. There will be no monetary loss to the club if we must cancel and all checks received for entries will be shredded in the event of cancellation.

The high scoring HRKC member will receive a prize made by Camille. Lorraine asked to have the Premium sent to her for posting on the club website. Parking will be limited to 15 at a time. Premium will be posted on HRKC website, Facebook page, PNW Working Dogs, and more. Chris Cornell requested fliers for distribution.

All Breed: The City of Sequim and Sequim High School will not confirm our dates for the 2021 ARO and All-Breed shows until the County enters Phase 3. We will need to think of alternate locations for our shows if we are unable to hold them at these locations.

Chris Cornell has been communicating with the show chairs for the Rose City Classic regarding their request to change their January Cluster to potentially the same weekend as our show. This would be very devastating to our entries and Chris has made it very clear to both AKC and the Oregon show committees that we strongly oppose any effort to have their shows the same weekend as our HRKC show dates. Chris will be touching base in January for both ARO and All Breed.

Old Business: Due to the new COVID restrictions, our Annual Meeting will be held only via Zoom. Braggs: Ben announced that Briggs went Select 2 days at Coeur d'Alene, and Tilly went BOS in Monroe. They brought a Papillon back from Idaho for Nancy Radich.

Lorraine announced that HRKC Member Faerin Tait handled her German Pinscher, Rookie in her first Juniors competitions in Coeur d'Alene, Idaho and they won 1st place in two out of three shows. Faerin also handled Rookie in Breed and went Winners Dog.

On November 14th and 15th, Lorraine and Howard took Riot and Saffron to the ABTC Scentwork Trials in Chehalis, WA. Riot Qualified in 7/8 searches and placed in the ribbons every day. Riot earned his AKC Scentwork Novice Title as well as qualified in Advanced Interior and Exterior. Saffron finished her Buried Excellent title, earned two legs in Interior Excellent and finished her Container Master Title with a 1st place finish. Saffron is now the first German Pincher with a Master Title.

Ben announced that the Clallam Valley Workshop performance of the Nutcracker will be filmed and shown at the Wheel In Motor Theater in Port Townsend,
