HURRICANE RIDGE KENNEL CLUB GIVES BACK TO COMMUNITY

The Hurricane Ridge Kennel Club is an AKC Licensed All-Breed Club and Non-Profit. Each year our club members work tirelessly to put on three canine events in Sequim and Port Angeles. In May 2023, our club held a Scentwork Trial at the Clallam County Fairgrounds in Port Angeles; in June we held a three day Agility-Rally-Obedience Trial at Carrie Blake Ballfields in Sequim and a three day All-Breed Show at the Carrie Blake Ballfields in July.

Each event brought hundreds of exhibitors to Clallam County who contributed tens of thousands to our local economy. These events generated proceeds which our club then donated to organizations nominated by our members. In 2023, our club donated a total of \$6,000.00 to the four organizations listed below:
